

I. General Provisions

1. **SK Sigma Olomouc, a. s.**, Legionářská 1165/12, 779 00 Olomouc, Business ID: 61974633 ("Operator") approves and issues this STADIUM RULES OF ENTRY ("Stadium Rules"), which sets out the **basic binding rules of conduct for all visitors to the Andrův stadium Olomouc**, ("Andrův Stadium" or "Stadium") who enter its premises and use its facilities.

2. The purpose of the Stadium Rules is to ensure the protection of life, health, property, and order in the stadium and to ensure, as far as possible, ideal conditions for all events to be held in the stadium. The purpose of the Stadium Rules is also to ensure a pleasant sporting and social atmosphere in the stadium. A ticket, unless otherwise specified, is also used in the Stadium Rules to mean a permanent ticket.

Each visitor, by purchasing a ticket and/or entering the stadium premises, expresses that they have fully and properly acquainted himself/herself with the Stadium Rules, that they have fully understood them, agrees with them, i.e. with their content and all the conditions set out therein, and undertakes to observe and respect them, and considers it to be fully binding, and expressly agree in particular to the obligation to pay any contractual penalties within the meaning of Part VI. (3) Prohibitions of the Stadium Rules.

II. Andrův Stadium

1. Andrův Stadium is open to the public for sporting, cultural, and social events, and its Operator decides how it is used.

2. The public may enter the stadium area only with the consent of the Operator, exclusively at the time specified by the Operator or, in exceptional cases, by another decision of the stadium owner, and only in compliance with the conditions set out in the Stadium Rules.

3. The Stadium Rules are also binding for all persons who will use the stadium for their events based on a special contract concluded for a specific purpose, as well as for guests of these persons.

4. In addition to the Operator, the organizing or security service is also entitled to supervise and enforce the observance and respect of the Stadium Rules, or, within the scope of its legal authority, the Police of the Czech Republic or the Municipal Police.

III. Stay at the Stadium

1. Only persons who have a valid ticket or other document authorizing entry or persons who can prove their right to stay in the Stadium in another way may stay in the Stadium. Every person inside the Stadium is obliged to prove their right to stay with a valid ticket or an authorizing document upon request by the Operator, the organizing or security service, as well as the Czech Republic Police or the Municipal Police. Anyone unable to prove their authorization to be in areapremisesto stay at the Stadium, will be escorted from the area. Upon leaving the Stadium, the ticket loses its validity, which also applies to the holder of a permanent ticket regarding the entitlement to enter the event for a specific game day.

2. The Stadium is always open to the public at least one hour before the start of the event until one hour after the end of the event, unless otherwise specified by the Operator.
3. The visitor acknowledges that all areas of the Stadium and its immediate surroundings are monitored by a camera system with the possibility of recording.
4. Any person entering the vicinity of the Stadium and the internal areas of the stadium agrees, without further notice, to the free of charge taking and use of their image or likeness as part of any visual and/or audio recording, transmission or reproduction of an event held in the Stadium, both for the purposes of press, radio, television or similar coverage and for commercial, promotional or marketing purposes, in the context of displaying all or part of the event in connection with the Operator and its contractual partners. This consent is granted for an indefinite period.
5. Visitors are obliged to occupy only the seat indicated on the ticket for the event. Fans and supporters of the visiting team are obliged to stay only in the sector designated by the Operator for supporters of the visiting team and are obliged to respect the organizational instructions of the organizing or security service, or officers of the Police of the Czech Republic or the Municipal Police.
6. For security reasons and to avert danger, visitors are obliged to take other seats than those indicated on the ticket, possibly in another sector, on the instructions of the organizing or security service, as well as the Police of the Czech Republic or the Municipal Police. The same applies to visitors who arrive after the event has started.
7. Persons who are obviously under the influence of alcohol or other psychotropic or addictive substances, as well as persons who threaten the life, safety of persons or property in the stadium, lose their right to stay in the entire stadium area and may be escorted out of the stadium area at any time by the organizing or security service, or by members of the Police of the Czech Republic or the Municipal Police.
8. In justified cases, the Operator is entitled to unilaterally define that certain parts or areas of the stadium can only be purchased or access granted if the previously announced conditions are met (according to club affiliation, admission without external club identification, etc.).
9. The presence of persons under 2 years of age is generally not recommended in the Stadium. Exceptions may be negotiated between the legal representative and the Operator or determined by the nature of the event.
10. The Operator is entitled to sell tickets at risk events only on presentation of an identity card (e.g., ID card, passport, driving license, etc.), where the date of birth and the ticket holder's name will be printed on the ticket. Entry to the Stadium premises will then be allowed at the entrance control only upon presentation of an identity card, where the data on the card must match the data printed on the ticket or permanent ticket.

IV. Access Control

1. Upon entering the stadium premises, each visitor is required to present their ticket or other document authorizing their stay or entry to the organizing or security service upon request and to provide it for inspection during their stay at the Stadium. At the request of the organizing or security

service, visitors are obliged to prove their identity with an ID card or other valid identification upon entering the Stadium premises and at any time during their stay. Anyone unable to prove their identity may be escorted from the Stadium area or denied entry to the Stadium.

2. Members of the organizing or security services as well as the Police of the Czech Republic and the Municipal Police are authorized to carry out a check and search of persons upon entering the Stadium premises, and in justified cases at any time during their stay at the Stadium, aimed at observing the prohibition of bringing unauthorized objects according to the Stadium Rules or in cases of minimizing the security risk for the event.

The obligation to undergo a search also applies to clothing, luggage, objects, or boxes brought in, so that the individual items can be inspected and their safety assessed.

3. It is forbidden to bring objects into the stadium area that may in any way endanger the life, health, or safety of persons staying in the stadium area, or may endanger the property of persons present or the property of the Stadium Operator. The organizer, security service, or, in individual cases, a person authorized by the Operator, is authorized to decide on the prohibition of bringing such items into the Stadium premises.

4. Persons who cannot prove their authorization to visit or enter the Stadium premises or persons who pose a security risk within the meaning of the Stadium Rules will not be allowed to enter the Stadium. The Operator reserves the right to refuse access to the Stadium to persons who have been banned in the Czech Republic, whether by public authorities or by the organizers of similar events, for disorderly conduct at such events. The Operator also reserves the right to refuse access to the Stadium to persons who other clubs have banned from entering their Stadiums. Persons denied entry to Andrův Stadium are not entitled to a refund.

V. Behavior in the Stadium

1. Every visitor to the Stadium is obliged to behave in such a way as to avoid damaging any property and facilities of the Stadium, its equipment, or damaging the property or health of other persons, and is also obliged to maintain cleanliness and order throughout the Stadium. Each visitor is also obliged not to restrict or disturb other persons by their behavior while watching the event that is currently taking place in the Stadium area.

2. Visitors are obliged to follow the regulations and instructions and obey the calls of the organizing or security service, as well as the Police of the Czech Republic, Municipal Police, firefighters, and medical rescue services and the announcer.

3. Visitors are obliged to respect the generally binding regulations, rules of decent behavior and good manners, i.e., especially politeness and consideration for other visitors to the Stadium, and are obliged to refrain from any manifestations of interpersonal, racial, religious, or political intolerance. In the event of a violation or disregard of this provision, the visitor committing an obviously prohibited act may be immediately escorted from the Stadium area without prior warning.

4. All entrances and exits, as well as escape routes from the Stadium, must be kept clear at all times, and every visitor to the stadium is required to act accordingly.

VI. Prohibitions

1. Visitors are prohibited from bringing the following items or other items of a similar nature or purpose into the Stadium area and keeping them on their person in the Stadium area:

- a/ racist, defamatory, vulgar or immoral material, in particular but not exclusively stickers and flags,
- b/ weapons of any kind, as well as all objects usable as weapons, such as chopping, striking, or stabbing weapons or objects,
- c/ sprays, corrosive, flammable, and dye substances or other containers with substances endangering protected interests,
- d/ bottles, cups/jars, jugs, cans/tins or similar items, in particular those made of brittle, breakable or hard material,
- e/ bulky items such as a ladder, stool, chair, box, pram, or car seat,
- f/ fireworks, firecrackers, flares, smoke bombs, and other pyrotechnic objects, including launchers,
- g/ any poles, including telescopic poles (even those designed for flags), banners except with the express consent of the Operator,
- h/ mechanically driven tools, machinery, or equipment causing excessive noise, e.g., sirens,
- i/ alcoholic beverages, drugs of any kind, toxic, narcotic, or psychotropic substances,
- j/ animals (except guide dogs, assistance, and service dogs, and only if the operator's consent is expressly granted),
- k/ laser pointers,
- l/ suitcases, large bags, large rucksacks, and other bulky items of a similar nature,
- m/ cameras, video cameras, and other devices and equipment for the purpose of professional sound or image recording, except with the prior and express consent of the Operator (e.g., in the form of accreditation),
- n/ own food and soft drinks,
- o/ bring in and distribute materials promoting a political party or movement, or any politically oriented materials.

2. It is also forbidden for visitors to:

a/ utter, disseminate, or publicly display racist, defamatory, vulgar, or immoral slogans or displays. Visitors are also prohibited from expressing any form of interpersonal, racial, religious, or political intolerance,

b/ promote any political party or movement, or any product or service associated with it,

c/ light, kindle, or maintain a fire,

d/ climb, climb over, or otherwise overcome, structures and equipment intended for general use, in particular facades, fences, walls, play area fencing, barriers, lighting equipment, camera stands, trees, poles of any kind, and climb on roofs,

e/ enter areas that are not designated or permitted for visitors (e.g., playing field, stadium facilities, indoor areas, officials' rooms) or enter areas where the visitor does not have a valid permit or ticket,

f/ throw objects or liquids of any kind onto the playing surface, into areas around the playing surface, or into visitor areas,

g/ ignite or shoot pyrotechnic articles or similar objects (in particular fireworks, flares, smoke bombs, cannons, etc.),

h/ destroy, take possession of, move, remove, or take away things, facilities, and equipment of the Stadium, possibly owned by third parties,

i/ without permission to sell tickets and any goods promoting the brand SK Sigma Olomouc or Andrův Stadium,

j/ write on, paint or label buildings, facilities, equipment, walkways or paths in the Stadium,

k/ perform their physical needs outside the toilets or pollute the Stadium premises in any other way, especially by throwing things away,

l/ ride on roads and areas without special permission,

m/ to take or use, in any way, without the prior written consent of the Operator, photographs and/or audio or visual recordings of the Stadium and the event for commercial purposes. It is further prohibited to collect, transmit, create, or disseminate any information, data, or information relating to, for example, match development, behavior, or any other factor or fact in any match (whether by electronic devices or otherwise) for the purpose of any form of betting, gambling, or commercial activity not previously authorized,

n/ cover advertising panels, information boards or safety signals, camera systems or electronic security systems located in the Stadium with banners, flags, tarpaulins or other similar means,

o/ violate the imposed ban on entering the Stadium premises,

p/ smoking, including electronic cigarettes and the use of any devices for heated tobacco and similar devices in the Stadium premises (except for the premises reserved by the Operator),

q/ physically or verbally assault anyone, especially but not exclusively other Stadium visitors and members of the organizing or security services,

r/ cover their face with a scarf, hood, or otherwise to make it difficult or impossible to identify their person when entering the Stadium and throughout the Stadium area.

3. Anyone who violates any of the above-mentioned prohibitions, restrictions, or regulations arising from these Stadium Rules is obliged to pay a contractual penalty of up to CZK 50,000 to SK Sigma Olomouc, a.s. for each such individual violation.

The contractual penalty is payable upon demand by SK Sigma Olomouc, a.s., within 10 days from the date of delivery of the payment demand. The amount of the contractual penalty is determined in proportion to the circumstances and the importance of the obligations secured.

In addition to the contractual penalty, the Operator is entitled to claim from anyone who violates the aforementioned prohibitions, restrictions and regulations, compensation for damages caused as a result of the prohibited act or restriction, in its entirety (the provisions of Section 2050 of Act No. 89/2012 Sb. of the Civil Code do not apply), including the payment of sanctions imposed by the organizer of the relevant football competition (FACR, LFA, UEFA, FIFA).

In addition, the Operator is also entitled to prohibit anyone who violates the provisions of the Stadium Rules or the prohibitions or restrictions set out above from entering the Stadium for a specified period or, depending on the severity of the offence, permanently, as well as from entering football matches or other programs held at the Stadium, as well as from entering other and training areas, and to refuse the sale of tickets for outdoor sports matches for which the Operator distributes ticket sales.

VII. Sales and Advertising

Business activities, including the distribution or sale of newspapers, magazines, printed materials, and advertising brochures, as well as the storage of items inside the Stadium, are allowed only with the prior written consent of the Operator.

VIII. Operator's Rights and Supervision

The right to perform the function of the Operator is also vested in the authorized representative of the Operator and, in the case of organized events, also in the organizer and security service, as well as the Police of the Czech Republic and the Municipal Police.

IX. Liability for Damages

1. Each visitor enters and uses the Stadium premises at their own risk. Persons under the age of 18 are the responsibility of their legal representatives. The Operator is liable for personal injury and property damage caused by the intentional or grossly negligent conduct of its employees or persons in a similar relationship of dependence.

2. Visitors are obliged to report any injuries and damages to the Operator immediately.

X. Violation of the Rules

1. Persons who violate the provisions of the visitor regulations may be removed from the Stadium without compensation and banned from entering the Stadium. The same applies to persons who are obviously under the influence of alcohol or other addictive substances. If a criminal offence, misdemeanor, or other administrative offence is suspected, a report may be made to the designated authorities.

A person staying in the Stadium area based on a permanent ticket who violates the provisions of the Stadium Rules may have their permanent ticket (or all permanent tickets held by such person) invalidated, with the consequence that such person may be banned from entering Andrův Stadium.

Persons who violate the ban imposed on them will be subject to a contractual fine of CZK 50,000.

2. The measures referred to in paragraph 1 of this section exclude claims (e.g., refund of admission fees) against the Operator of the event.

3. The rights of the Operator remain unaffected.

XI. Personal Data Protection

Visitors acknowledge that the entire stadium facility and adjacent areas are monitored by industrial cameras and that photographs, video, and audio recordings may be taken at any time during their stay at the Stadium.

Visitors acknowledge that SK Sigma Olomouc, a.s., as well as the Football Association of the Czech Republic ("FACR") and the League Football Association ("LFA"), as controllers, may process the personal data of any visitor, even without the consent of the data subject, if this is necessary to protect the rights and legally protected interests of the controller, the recipient or any other person concerned. The purpose of processing personal data is to ensure the safety of persons and property in stadiums, and to prevent access to the stadiums by individuals who commit violations of visitor regulations or engage in illegal acts within the Stadiums. For this purpose, the controllers may also transfer this personal data to other persons, in particular to other football clubs in the Czech Republic.

The personal data processed may include name, surname, date of birth, residential address, identity document number, photographs, visual and audio recordings, a description of the conduct that is considered to be in breach of the Stadium Rules or unlawful conduct, and information about measures taken and penalties imposed.

Any visitor who discovers or believes that the controller or processor is processing their personal data in a manner that violates the protection of the data subject's private and personal life or is contrary to the law may request an explanation from the controller or processor or request that the controller or processor remedy the situation. In particular, this may involve blocking, correcting, supplementing, or destroying personal data.

XII. Changes to the Stadium Rules of Entry

1. The Operator has the right to make a reasonable change to the Stadium Rules in the event of a reasonable need for change (in particular following developments in the legal environment, changes in the approach of the relevant supervisory authority, to improve the quality of the services provided, etc.). In such a case, the Operator will publish the new version of the Stadium Rules on the website well in advance of their entry into force. Should any provision of the Stadium Rules become invalid, the validity of the other provisions shall remain unaffected.

XIII. Effect

These Stadium Rules of Entry of Andrův Stadium Olomouc are effective from 25. 7. 2025.
